PROCEEDING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING OF DISTRICT MINERAL FOUNDATION HELD ON 02.03.2021 UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SRI ABDAAL M AKHTAR, IAS, COLLECTOR KORAPUT & CHAIRPERSON CUM MANAGING TRUSTEE, DMF TRUST, KORAPUT AT 11.00 AM IN SADBHABANA SABHAGRUHA, KORAPUT

The Board of Trustees meeting of DMF was held on 02.03.2021 under the Chairpersonship of Sri Abdaal M Akhtar, IAS, Collector Koraput & Chairperson cum Managing Trustee, DMF, Koraput at 11.00 am in Sadbhabana Sabha Gruha, Koraput. The list of Members & officials present in the meeting is enclosed in **Annexure-I**.

At the outset, PD DRDA cum CEO, DMF welcomed all the Board Members as well as the Executing Agencies for the Board of Trustees Meeting of 2020-21 financial year and requested the Collector & Chairperson cum Managing Trustee, DMF to preside over the meeting. The PD DRDA cum CEO DMF initiated the discussion as per the agenda enclosed in **Annexure-II.**

Prior to the agenda wise discussion, the PD DRDA cum CEO DMF requested the Collector & Chairperson cum Managing Trustee, DMF to deliver the key note address, which is noted as follows:

Collector & Chairperson cum Managing Trustee, DMF:

- The Annual Action Plan for the financial year 2020-21 shall be prepared in the ratio of 90::10 for directly affected as well as indirectly affected area respectively.
- While preparing the Annual Action Plan 2020-21, main concern shall be given to the High Priority sectors like Livelihood, education, connectivity, health care, welfare of women & children etc.
- DMF fund is an extra budgetary allocation for the District; hence, while implementing, all
 agencies should commit to memory the sole purpose of inclusive development in affected
 areas by dovetailing the diversities.
- All Executive Agencies shall act upon the strict directives of ODMF Rule.
- To come out of Covid-19 line of defence, preferences shall be given to Livelihood upliftment in convergence mode through OLM, ORMAS, ITDA, Agriculture, Horticulture, Mission Shakti, and Watershed.
- While creating any asset under DMF, standard should be set and the quality should be superior to the other schemes, which necessitate united effort, transparency, timely completion & desired transformation.

Afterwards the PD Cum CEO requested all Hon'ble BOTs to express their views on finalization of Annual Action Plan 2020-21.

Hon'ble MLA Pottangi:

Enquired on the physical & financial progress of previous years & sanction of funds.

- Suggested all Executing agencies to make DMF funds as model and execute the projects so as to emulate the same in other areas.
- Focussed on Connectivity & irrigation projects.

Hon'ble MLA Laxmipur:

- · Focussed on the utilization of DMF Funds towards managing the natural resources.
- Suggested to extend cooperation towards larger interests of developing the mining affected areas.
- Enquired on the progress of the projects sanctioned in last year w.r.t. Laxmipur, Dasmantpur & Narayanpatna.
- Education & Drinking Water projects shall be taken in priority basis.
- Repair & renovation of electrical projects (transformer) are to be taken up by the EE Southco/TPSL in priority basis out of their own fund.

Hon'ble Chairman, District Planning Committee & MLA Koraput:

- Looking at the post Covid-19 scenario, DMF projects shall be very crucial in revamping the life & livelihood.
- Requested the Board to finalize the AAP in terms of the gaps identified in the Mining area.
- Prioritised on taking up projects under Connectivity, Education, Women & Child care sectors.
- Enquired on the progress of NALCO mining area projects taken up in 2019-20.
- Suggested to take up, need based & qualitative projects which can look up to the magnificence of DMF.

Hon'ble MP (LS) Koraput:

- Basic infrastructural projects in OMC affected area is to be covered in OMC CSR separately other than the DMF allocation.
- Electrical projects in the mining affected areas shall be completed in war footing manner & the completed projects are to be verified, whether the sanctioned numbers are being installed in the same location or not.
- Drinking water projects in affected areas are to be taken up & completed before the peak summer season.
- Focussed on Livelihood generation in the affected areas.
- After completion of the projects, concerned BOTs are to be invited for official inauguration.
- Special provision in terms of Livelihood, Drinking water, Education, Connectivity and Irrigation sectors for Kotiya group of villages are to be kept in the DMF AAP 2020-21.

Subsequently, PD DRDA presented the compliance on the proceedings of the last BOT meeting & shared the Physical and Financial progress of DMF Trust Koraput, which is given in **Annexure-III**.

Besides, some of the important points of the minutes of the BOT meeting are as follows:

- The President Zilla Parishad, Koraput suggested to take up Lamtaput area under DMF Koraput.
- The remunerations of the Drivers of Ambulance & Dead Body Carriers (Sanctioned in 2019-20) are to be sanctioned out of the DMF Administrative, Supervisory & Overhead Expenses based on the certification given by CDM & PHO and RTO, Koraput.
- Annual Action Plan is to be shared with all BDOs, Executing Agencies & Hon'ble BOTs for transparency and to check up the duplicacy of the projects. Likewise, all Agencies are to share their Project list with the DMF Cell, DRDA to verify the duplicacy before finalization of Action Plan.
- The board unanimously decided to approve the required fund to refill the LPG connections sanctioned out of DMF.
- The 500 Seated Auditorium at Koraput project is to be expedited by the EE R & B Koraput by acquiring land from his Residence area. The EE R & B Koraput has to initiate the work in consultation with the ADM Koraput.
- Eco-Tourism projects for Deomali & other important places of Koraput District are to be funded out of DMF.
- Highly needed connectivity & Physical infrastructure projects are to be taken up for both directly & indirectly affected areas.
- The Board unanimously decided to keep Rs. 2.00 crores as corpus fund for Promotion of Commercial-Agro Farm & Livelihood activities in directly affected areas covering agriculture, horticulture, livestock, and fishery through SHG & Producers Group.
- The Board unanimously decided to take up smart classes in Class IX & X for selected High Schools including EMRS Pungar, Central Schools & JNV Landiguda.
- The Board unanimously decided to provide Battery Operated Tri-Cycles to Dibyanga in directly affected areas & procure Vacuum based diesel truck mounted road sweeping machines for all ULBs of this District.
- All hostels & AWCs of directly affected area shall be a Model, covering all basic necessities.
- The uncovered areas especially the hamlets shall also be illuminated.
- All projects shall be documented by the Executing Agencies & a documentation cell shall be set up at DMF Cell, DRDA for dedicated documentation of DMF works.
- All Executing agencies are to keep display board (Transparency Pillar) uniformly with precise information (in ODIA, ENGLISH language & DMF Logo).

Display Board shall be of terracotta colour background and white coloured write up in both sides containing precise information & DMF Logo. The size is 3 ft (width) x 4 ft (height).

- Audit report for the FY 2019-20 has been placed before the BOTs and unanimously approved by the Hon'ble BOTs.
- A list of 15 numbers of projects amounting to Rs. 157.13 lakhs taken up under DMF 2020-21 has been placed for post-facto approval & the Board unanimously approved the same. The copy is enclosed in Annexure-IV.
- ASO (Administrative, Supervisory & Overhead Contingency Expenses) for the FY 2021-22
 has been placed before the Hon'ble BOTs and the same has also been approved
 unanimously. The Copy is enclosed in Annexure-V.

 Expert agency shall be hired for finalization of Identification of affected areas, Base line survey of all villages (HH) in the affected areas, Designing of dedicated Website for the Trust & Compilation of Annual report by observing necessary formalities.

Finally, the Hon'ble Members unanimously approved the Annual Action Plan 2020-21, covering essential grievances, feasible & need based projects, after due scrutiny. AAP 2020-21 is enclosed in Annexure-VI.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
