

PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING OF DISTRICT MINERAL FOUNDATION KORAPUT HELD ON 4.7.2018 UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF SRI K. SUDARSHAN CHAKRAVARTHY, IAS, COLLECTOR CUM CHAIRMAN, DMF, KORAPUT AT 4.00 PM IN SADBHABANA SABHAGRUHA, KORAPUT

The Board of Trustees meeting on DMF was held on 4.7.2018 under the Chairmanship of Sri K. Sudarshan Chakravarty, IAS, Collector cum Chairman DMF, Koraput at 6.00 pm in Sadbhabana Sabha Gruha, Koraput. The list of members & officials present in the meeting is enclosed in **Annexure-I**.

At the outset, Collector-cum Chairman welcomed all board members as well as executing officials present and asked PD, DRDA cum Chief Executive DMF to share the status of Annual Action Plan for the year 2018-19. Chief Executive, DMF cum PD DRDA enlightened about the sector wise allocation in the **directly affected** villages only, as decided during the last board meeting. Further, instructed the nodal officer to elucidate the projects in detail. After going through the detail project list and sectoral allocation, board of trustees suggested few changes with regard to the estimated cost of few educational & infrastructural projects, as per the requirement. In this connection Collector instructed the concerned executing agencies to submit their estimate in case to case basis so that the actual amount of the projects can be assessed. Accordingly projects will be sanctioned. Subsequent to the modifications & ground zero verification by Collector & other concerned, AAP 2018-19 has been finalised & unanimously approved by the board, which is enclosed in **Annexure-II**. Looking at the felt need, Board has decided to utilise 37% of total funds under high priority areas & 63% under other priority areas. Subsequently, prime focus will be given to the high priority areas, while projects of indirectly affected areas will be identified to compensate the total ratio of 60:40 (High priority 60% & Other Priority 40%).

While verifying the project list, board unanimously decided to go for central tender at District level intended for the items like procurement of equipments (Furniture/Fixtures etc.) for Schools, LED lights (street lights & high mast lights) by the concerned line departments.

(Action: PD DRDA cum CE DMF & Concern Executing Agencies)

Afterwards, as decided in the last meeting, Chairman of the scrutiny committee for inclusion of OMC affected villages in the DMF Village list, shared the findings and submitted the report where 71 villages are being proposed for inclusion. List along with report is enclosed in **Annexure-III**. In this connection, Collector invited objections from all members and set 30 days timeline for suggesting changes, if any.

Further, Collector instructed the Sub-Collector, Koraput to verify the affected villages of other mining areas of this District (apart from OMC) as per the guidelines and submit a detail report in this regard. The team of officials assigned vide proceeding copy memo no. 3529 dated 8.6.2018

of last BOT meeting & 3955 dated 29.6.2018 of PD DRDA cum CE DMF, has been instructed to complete the process under the Chairmanship of Sub-Collector Koraput. ORSAC, Bhubaneswar may be contacted to finalise the village list.

(Action: Sub Collector Koraput & Nodal Officer, DMF)

Likewise the Board decided to initiate the process of identification of projects for indirectly affected villages by 1st August 2018 which will be verified & prioritised in the next board meeting.

(Action: All Executing Agencies & Nodal Officer, DMF)

With regard to the Audit of 2017-18 financial years, PD DRDA cum CE placed all Audit reports of 2015-16, 2016-17 & 2017-18 in the Board and dully approved in the BOT meeting. Accordingly Collector instructed to send all reports along with the proceedings copy to the Department.

So far as the Annual Report compilation is concerned Collector instructed to hire an external agency/professional to compile & complete the process by 30th September 2018 positively.

(Action: All Executing Agencies & Nodal Officer, DMF)

While summing up the discussion, Collector instructed all executing agencies to complete the projects of previous years' and submit 100% UCs, by 30th July 2018 positively. In addition Collector instructed the Chief Executive cum PD DRDA to collect the estimates of all agencies by 23rd July. In this connection, board has unanimously decided to vet the same plan in the Gram Sabhas & send the Annual Action Plan & administrative cost proposal to Govt. in Planning & Convergence Deptt. for information & necessary action. With regard to the submission of MPR, Collector instructed all agencies to send their up to date status by 1st of every month positively.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
